

# MY NEW ADVENTURE: MOVING TO ARNEWOOD SCHOOL










### A NEW BEGINNING



# A BIGGER SCHOOL


My new school might be bigger than my current one. There will be more students, more classrooms and more teachers. That's okay!

I will learn where everything is, and there will be lots of people to help me.




### NEW TEACHERS AND STAFF

It's ok to ask for help




#### LEARNING NEW THINGS
